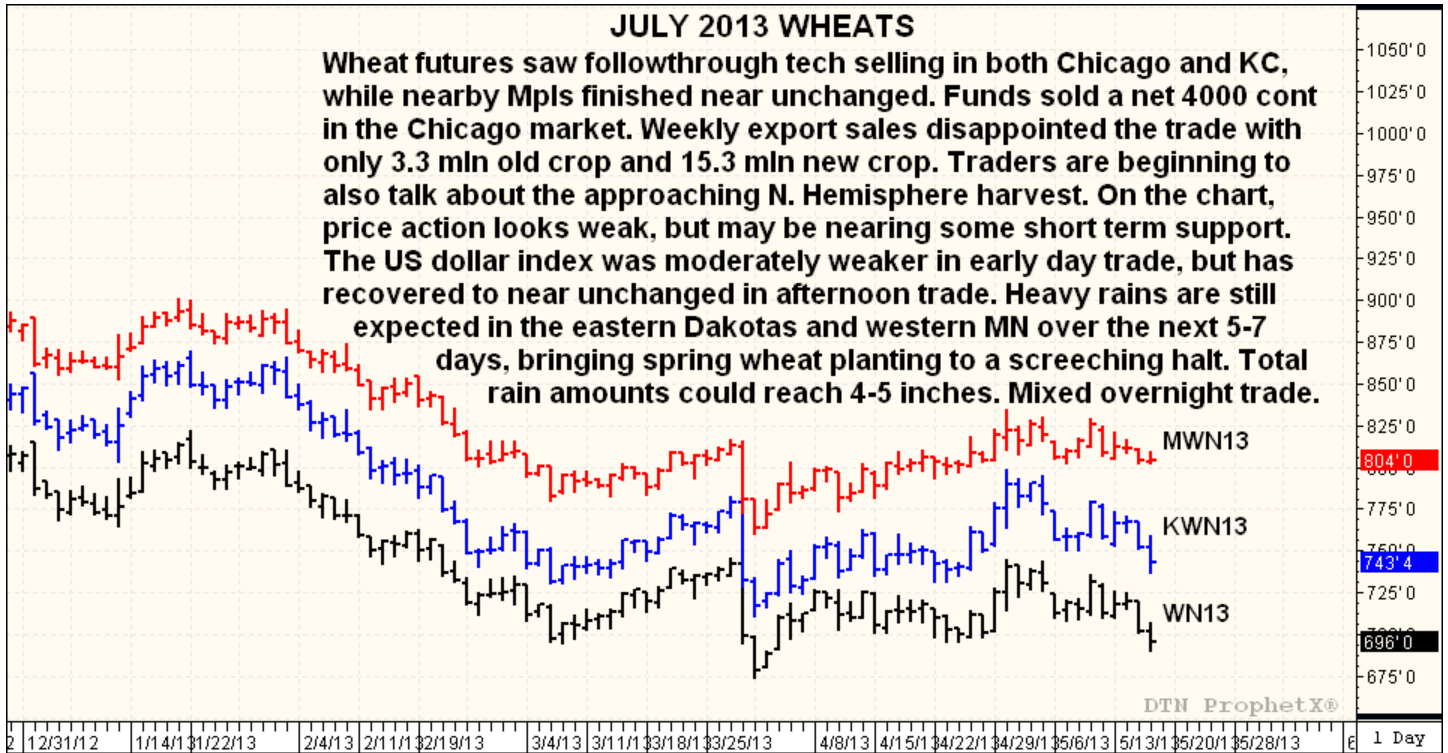
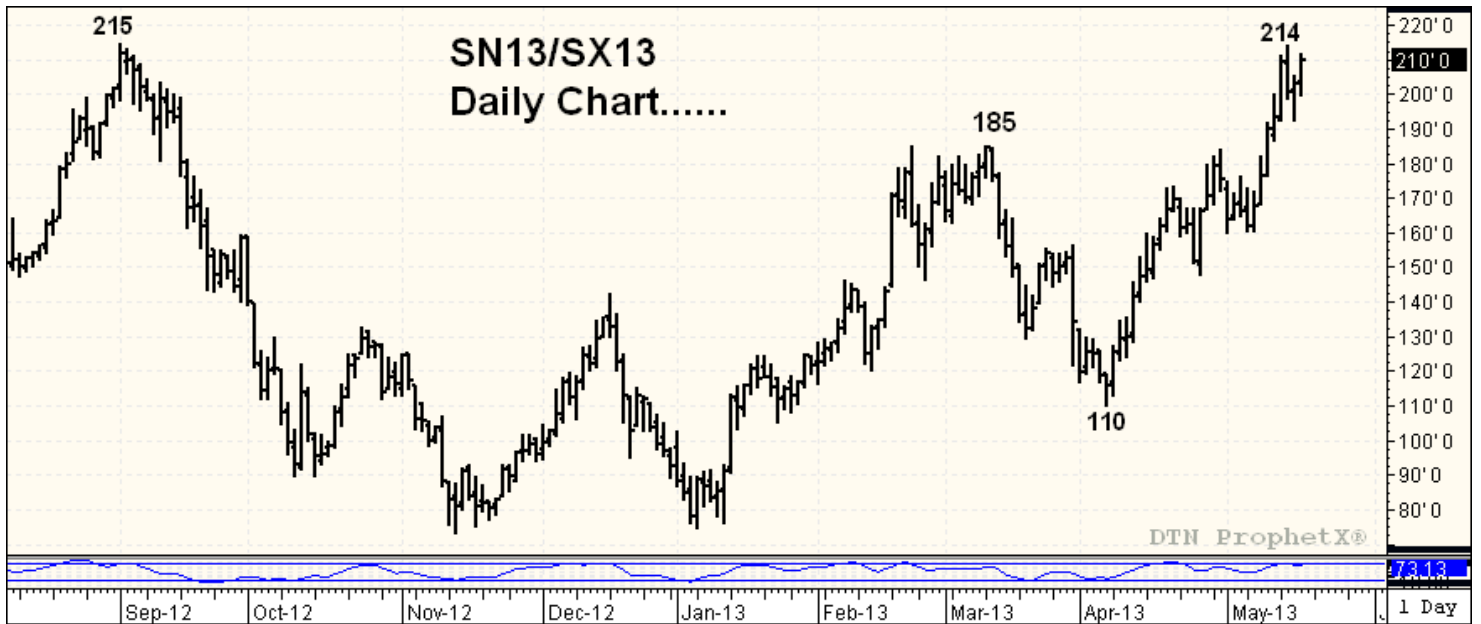


### JULY 2013 WHEATS

Wheat futures saw followthrough tech selling in both Chicago and KC, while nearby Mpls finished near unchanged. Funds sold a net 4000 cont in the Chicago market. Weekly export sales disappointed the trade with only 3.3 mln old crop and 15.3 mln new crop. Traders are beginning to also talk about the approaching N. Hemisphere harvest. On the chart, price action looks weak, but may be nearing some short term support. The US dollar index was moderately weaker in early day trade, but has recovered to near unchanged in afternoon trade. Heavy rains are still expected in the eastern Dakotas and western MN over the next 5-7 days, bringing spring wheat planting to a screeching halt. Total rain amounts could reach 4-5 inches. Mixed overnight trade.

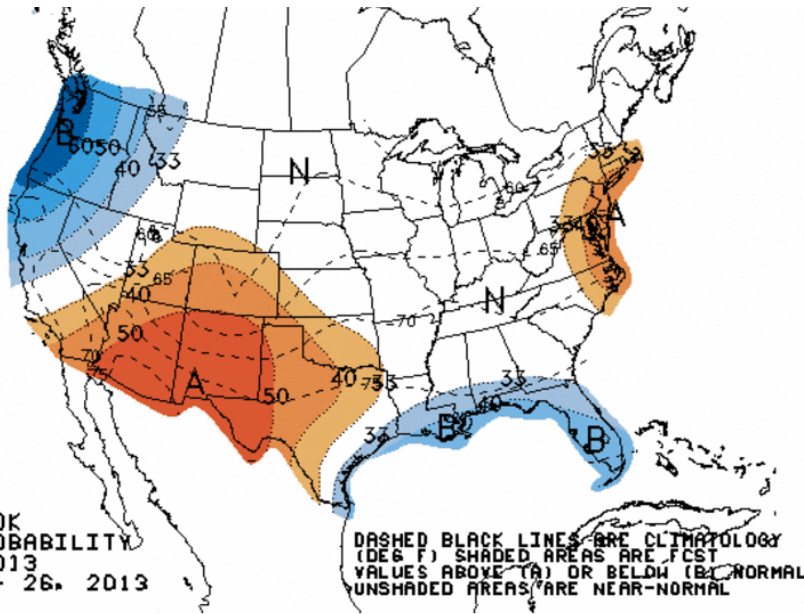

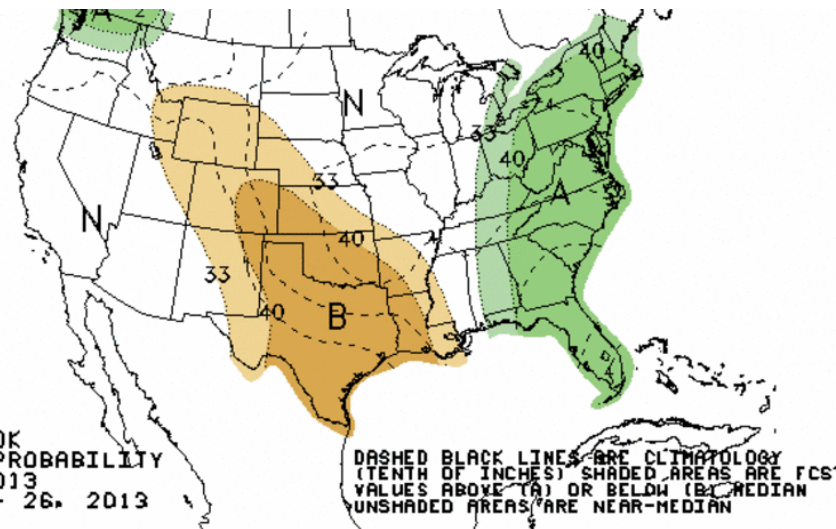




6-10 DAY OUTLOOK
